Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to announce that this year for Halloween Notre Dame is hosting "Dress like your favourite Character" for Friday, October 30th. On this day, students are invited to come to school dressed up as a character from a favourite book, movie, or show. There is no need to go out and buy a character costume, instead students are encouraged to gather an assortment of hats, clothing, signs, or other props to create a homemade costume. For example, to dress like Pippi Longstocking simply wear pigtails and long striped socks.

In past years, parents were able to come and watch students parade through the gym, but due to COVID-19 guidelines we will not be able to host parents watching in the gym this year.

To support students' feelings of safety and security in our building, violent or frightening costumes such as villains or monsters will not be considered acceptable. No weapons or dangerous looking items will be permitted to accompany a costume. This means, students are welcome to dress up as characters like Luke Skywalker, Batman, etc., as long as they do not bring any of their weapon-like accessories.

Below are some examples of both appropriate and inappropriate costumes, in order to better support your child in deciding on a costume:

Ramona	Grim Reaper
Superman, Spiderman, etc.	Zombies
Olivia	Monsters
Junie B. Jones	Ghosts
Geronimo Stilton	Goblins
Pippi Longstocking	Characters with guns/weapons
