Dear Parents and Guardians;

As you are likely aware, updates to the COVID-19 Public Health Guidance for K-12 Schools were released yesterday. The full document can be found on the BC Government website at

Notre Dame School has been diligently following all guidelines and requirements as outlined by the Provincial Health Officer, the Ministry of Education, and the British Columbia Centre for Disease Control, and will continue to do so. The above document can be viewed for more detailed information.

The new protocols will be in effect immediately. The changes that impact elementary schools include:

- Staff are required to wear a non-medical mask at all times, both within and outside of their learning group, except when:
 - Sitting in (or standing at) their seat or desk/workstation in a classroom or learning space
 - There is a barrier in place
 - Eating or drinking
 - Outdoors
- Singing is only permitted when staff and students are 2m physical distance following the guidelines. Masks are an added layer of protection for teachers and students but should not replace physical distancing or transparent barriers.

Daily Health Checker

The Ministry of Education has worked with Public Health and the BCCDC to create a daily health check website and mobile app that students and parents can use to complete before heading to school in the morning.
