Dear Notre Dame School Parents and Guardians;

After emailing out our Parent/Guardian letter yesterday (March 30) regarding masks in grades 4-9, BC schools received further guidance through the <u>Provincial COVID-19 Health</u> and <u>Safety Guidelines for K-12 Settings</u>. Below is an excerpt from page 29 of this document:

"All students in Grades 4-12 are required to wear a mask or a face shield (in which case a non-medical mask should be worn in addition to the face shield) indoors in school and on school buses both within and outside of their learning group.

Students in Grades K to 3 are encouraged to wear a mask indoors in schools and on school buses, but are not required to do so - mask wearing remains a personal or family/caregiver choice for these students, and their choices must be respected." (Page 29)

All BC schools are required to follow the Provincial COVID-19 Health and Safety Guidelines for K-12 Settings. As such, face masks are required for all Notre Dame School students in Grades 4-7. Please ensure your child in Grades 4-7 has a face mask with them each school day. The mask should be washed after each day or a new mask provided for the next day.

Exceptions are made for staff and students who cannot wear a mask for medical or other reasons; please contact Mrs. Colleen Richard if this pertains to you. The guidance outlined above regarding mask requirements does not apply to staff, students and visitors in the following circumstances:

- to a person who cannot tolerate wearing a mask for health or behavioural reasons;
- to a person who is unable to put on or remove a mask without the assistance of another person;
- if the mask is removed temporarily for the purposes of identifying the person wearing it;

• if the mask is removed temporarily to engage in an educational activity that cannot be performed while wearing a mask (e.g. playing a wind instrument, engaging in high-intensity physical activity, etc.);

- if a person is eating or drinking;
- if a person is behind a barrier; or

• while providing a service to a person with a disability or diverse ability (including but not limited to a hearing impairment) where visual cues, facial expressions and/or lip reading/movements is important.
